- ARTIST STATEMENT OR STATEMENT RELATED TO CURATORIAL/ADMINISTRATIVE GOALS- 250 WORDS OR LESS
- STATEMENT ABOUT WHY YOU WOULD LIKE TO BE A MEMBER OF GOOD CHILDREN GALLERY AND WHAT UNIQUE SKILLS/ CAPABILITIES YOU CAN CONTRIBUTE TO THE GALLERY- 250 WORDS OR LESS. (FOR EXAMPLE, MENTION IF YOU CAN HELP OUTREACH (SOCIAL MEDIA OR OTHERWISE), GRANT WRITING, WEBSITE MANAGEMENT, GALLERY PREPARATION, ETC.)
